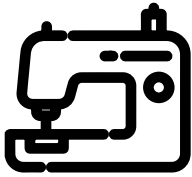


PRINTING TECHNIQUES INFO



Embroidery

Traditional textile technique consisting of sewing a design on a piece of garment.



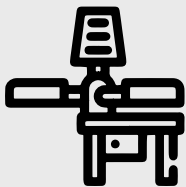
Direct digital printing

Print your design digitally. Amazing definition, quality and colour.



Laser

Engraving technique by high temperature printing on the object's surface.



Screen printing

Print your design by transferring the ink to the garment using mesh screens. One of the advantages of this technique is the design durability and its good results on the garments.



Pad printing

Perfect technique to print on curved shaped items, either small or big.



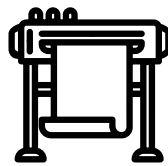
Vinyl

Technique based on a thermo adhesive plastic sheet in plain colours to print on garments.



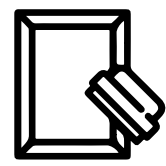
Sublimation

Printing technique in which the solid ink is turned into gas when brought under heat. Process applicable on textiles, mugs and bottles.



Digital transfer

Digital print of an image on adhesive vinyl to be transferred on the item by means of a digital plotter.



Screen print transfer

Combination of two techniques by firstly printing the design on a special release silicon paper to be transferred later onto the desired item.



Hat sewing

Hat bands stitching. This service includes the printing and/or sublimation on the sewn band.



Four-colour printing

Technique based on the use of four colours to print an image.



Thermography (low relief)

Technique based on the engraving of a design by heat (between 100 and 300 degrees Celsius) with a more durable result.
